

South Bethlehem Greenway Phases 1 & 2

City of Bethlehem | Northampton County, PA



Van Cleef was contracted by the City of Bethlehem for the Greenway project, Phases 1 & 2. The first two phases of this project included the construction of a pedestrian safety and enhancement improvement program within a project area consisting of the former Norfolk Southern (NS) Railroad Right-of-Way (ROW), on average sixty (60) feet in width.

Work within the Greenway right of way began on New Street and continued to Hayes Street in the City of Bethlehem, Northampton County. Van Cleef was involved in the survey and design of the greenway trail, pedestrian connections to key existing access points, storm water management and other miscellaneous improvements. Van Cleef in association with the City's Planning Consultant and public involvement, prepared construction documents and coordinated design with the City based upon input generated by the North East region of the PA Department of Conservation (DCNR) and Natural Resource and the Department of Recreation and Parks, in accordance with DCNR grant funding.
